Ensure the orientation is Portrait.



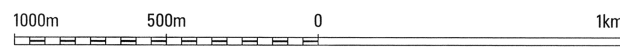

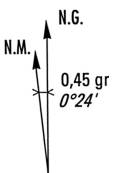
