3(a)(ii)	all values recorded ; <i>V</i> values decreasing ; <i>I</i> values decreasing ; <b>either</b> <i>V</i> to at least 1 d.p. <b>or</b> <i>I</i> to at least 2 d.p. ;	4
3(b)	all power values correct ; power values decreasing ;	2
3(c)	no / yes (to match results) and actual values used to show relationship / reference to how P changes with <i>I</i> ; doubling <i>I</i> does not double <i>P</i> (for no) / doubling <i>I</i> doubles <i>P</i> (for yes) or <i>P</i> / <i>I</i> not constant (for no) or <i>P</i> / <i>I</i> constant (for yes) ;	2
