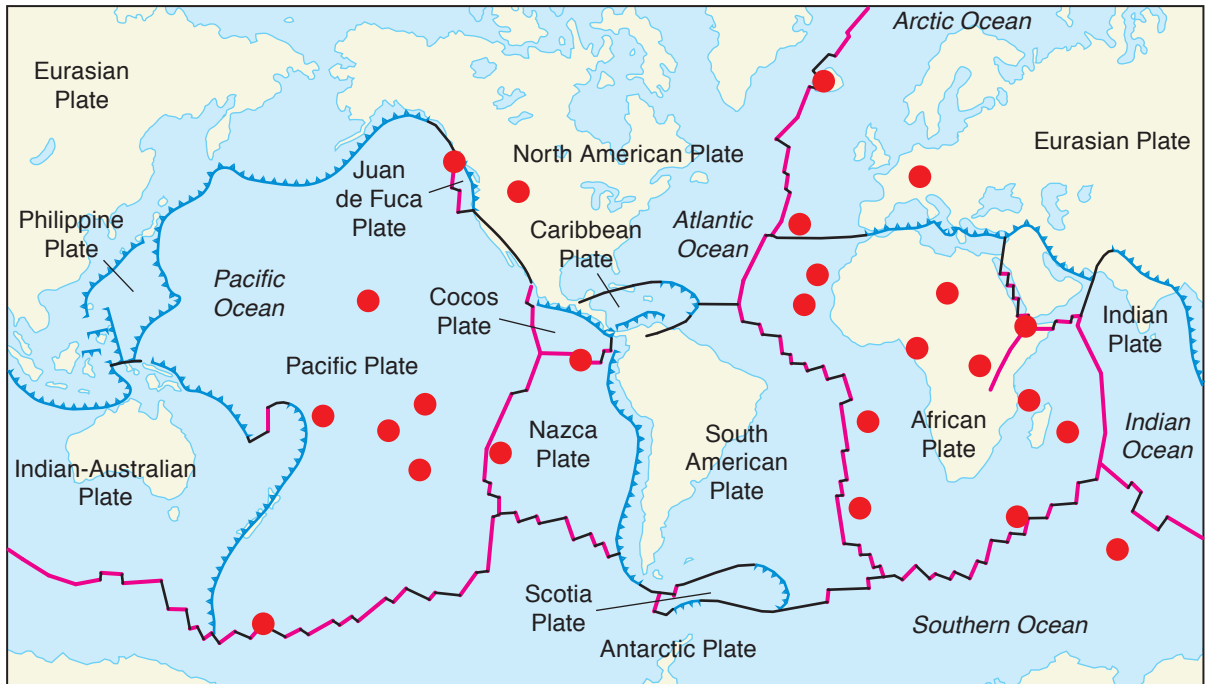

The percentage of residential addresses at risk from flooding in Great Britain

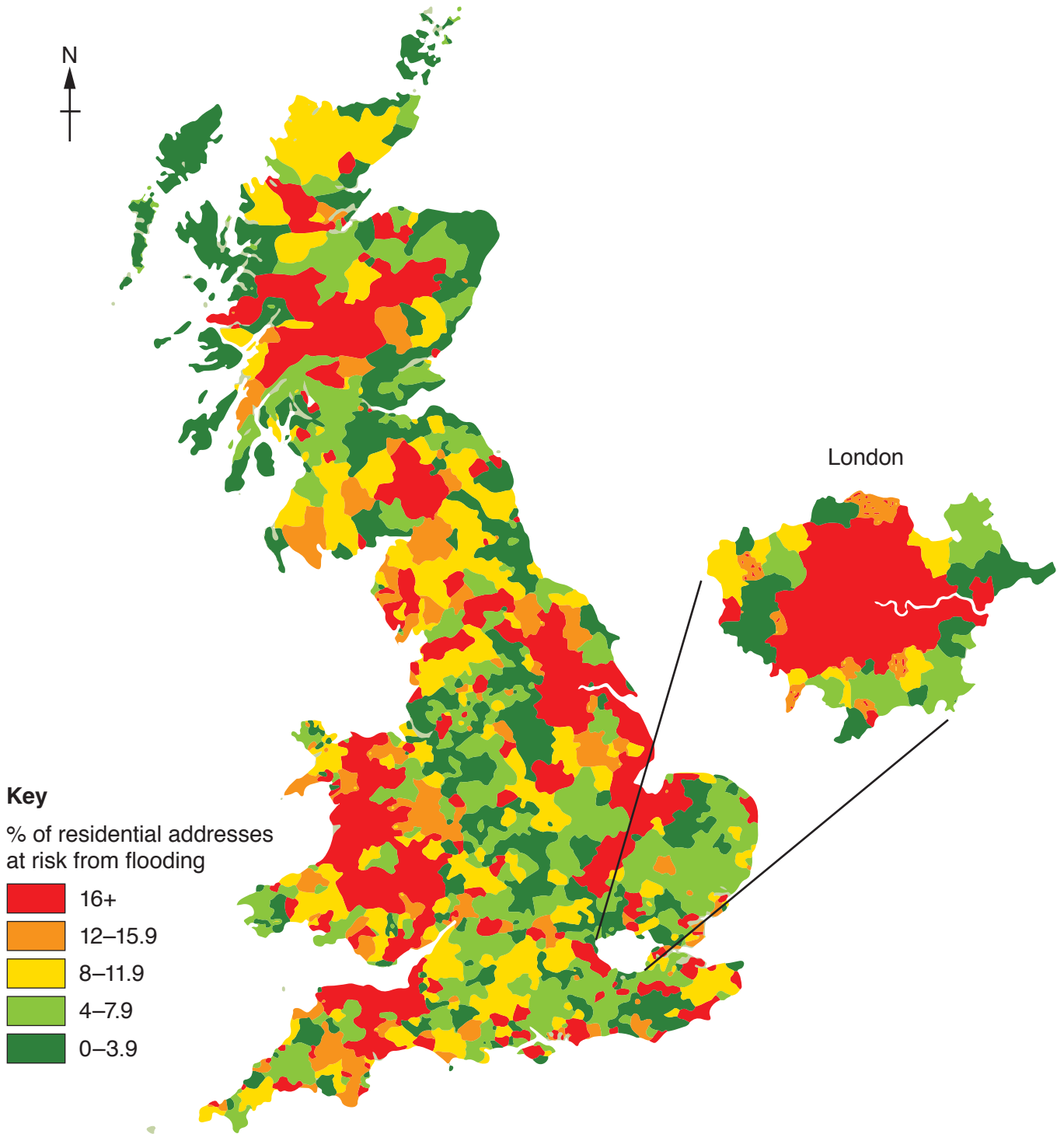

Murder rates (2003–2011) for England, Wales, Scotland and Northern Ireland

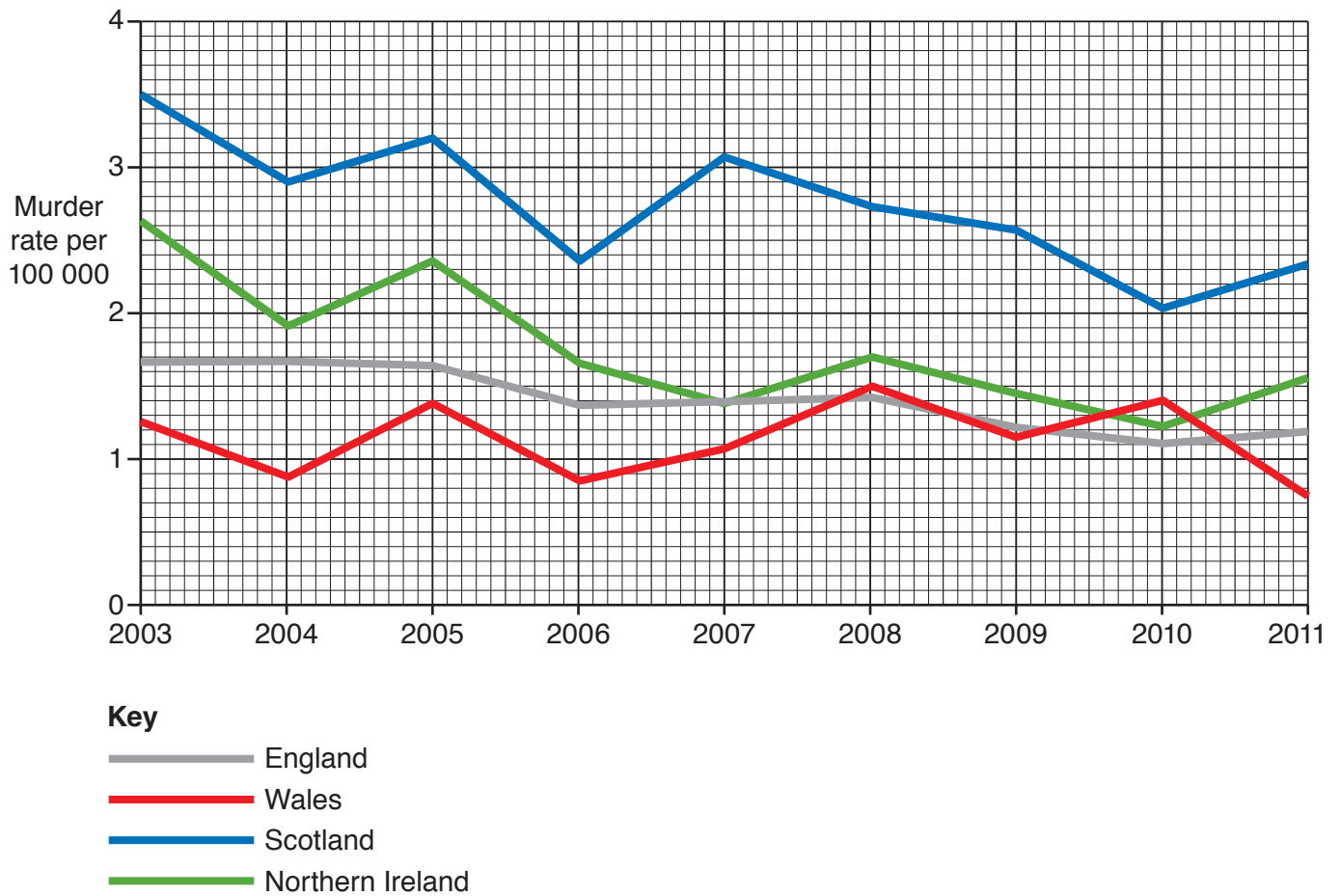
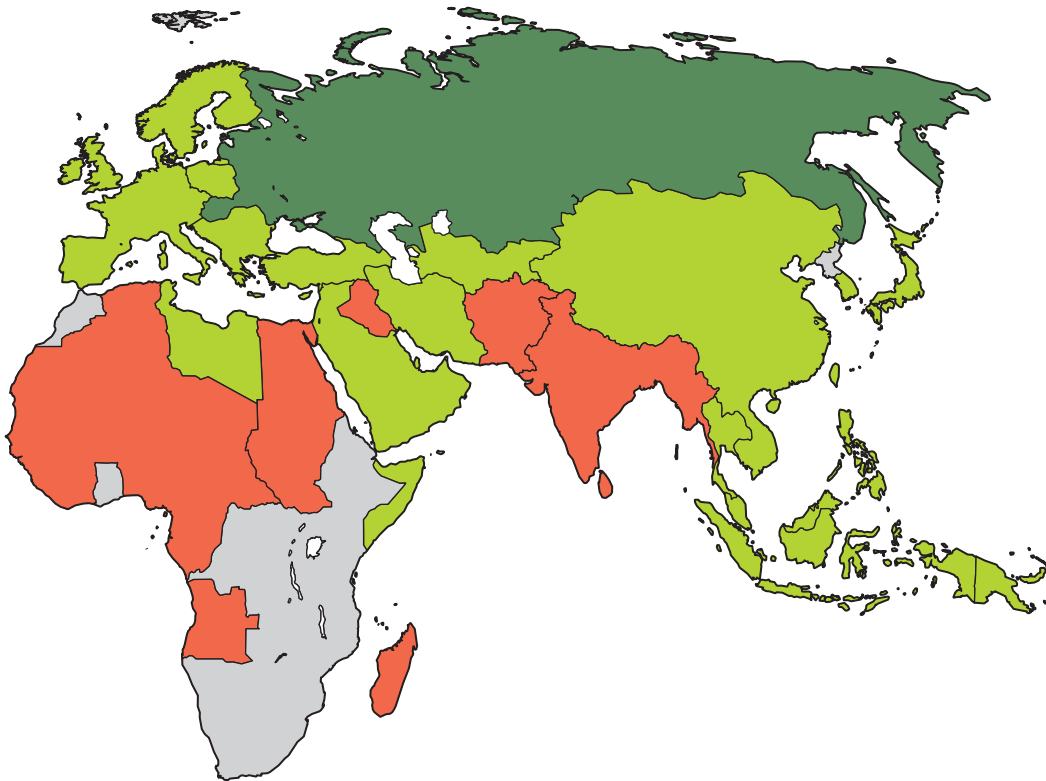

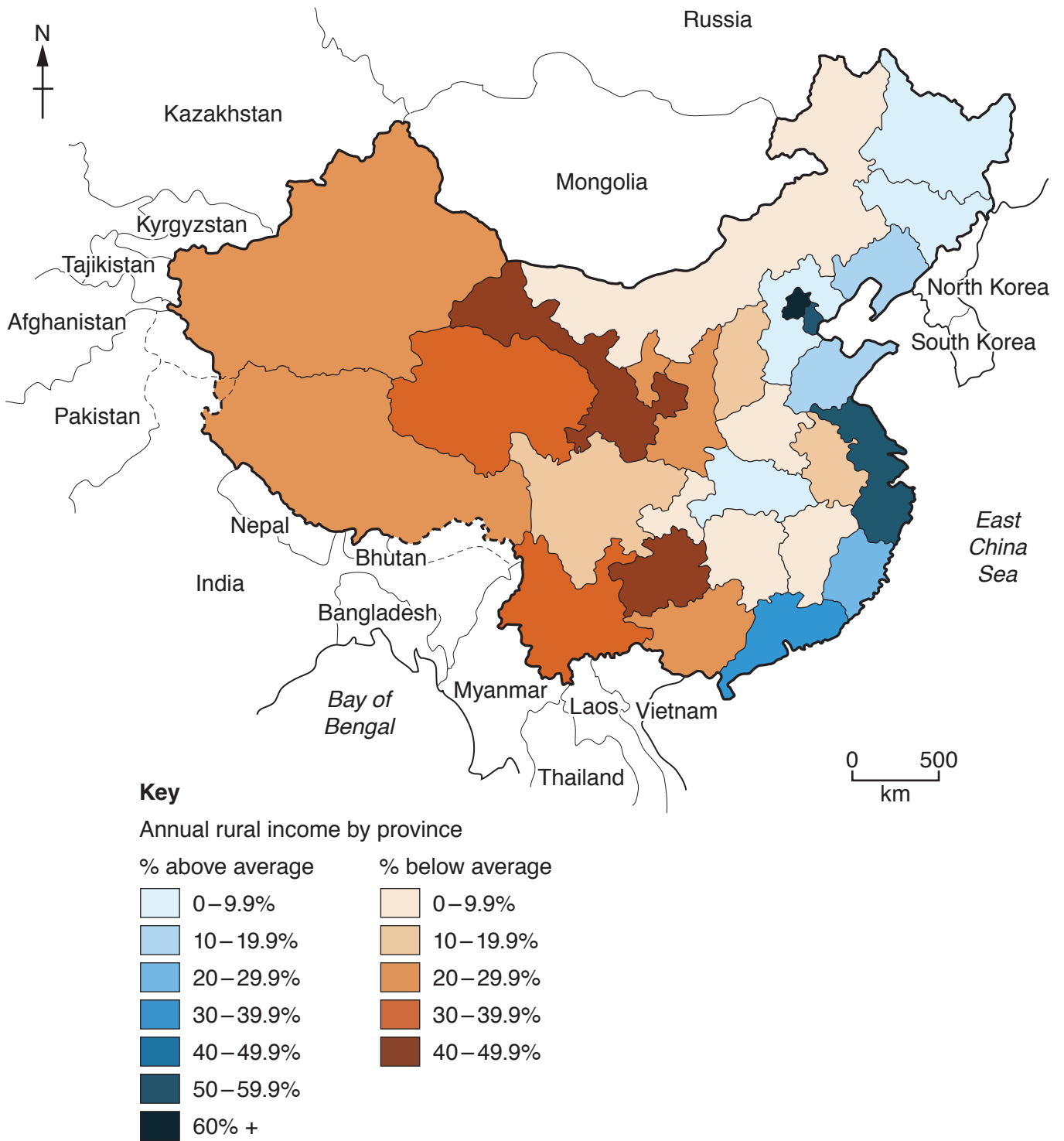
-  Category I Low child and low adult mortality
